Classical Civilization Minor Requirements

- five CLST courses, at least three at or above the 200-level (at least three of these must be taught by a primary or secondary member of the Duke Department of Classical Studies).
- Courses must be in at least two areas: literature (in translation at or above the 200-level and/or in the original language at or above the 250-level [*original language independent studies must be > 300*]), history, art and archaeology, or philosophy. In planning coursework for the minor students should consult with the DUS as to a given course's fit in the distribution.
- Note: CLST courses include cross-listed courses originating in other departments and study-abroad transfers; Greek and Latin courses below the 300 level other than Latin 251/252 and/or Greek 252S do not count toward the CLCIV minor
